

Using Get Article How to use our full text article retriever

Get Article allows researchers to retrieve available full text articles directly from citations found in most of the library's online databases. The retrieval can occur even if the full-text is provided by a different database or publisher. For each citation, a single mouse click will now display all options for obtaining the document. This resource includes all full text, downloadable sources as well as links to IIT's print collection and interlibrary loan (MyILL).

Look for the red button that accompanies the record in the database: 

Clicking on the icon opens a new window containing information on where to find the article. There are many options for obtaining the article:

1. Article is available in full text through another database:

If the **Online Full Text** option reads "**Full text available online via [database]**", it means the article is available through one of the library's other databases. Simply click "GO" and it will take you to the database, and usually directly to the article. If clicking "GO" does not take you to the exact article, you may have to browse through the publication to find the issue and article you need.

2. Article is not available in any online databases:

If the **Online Full Text** option reads "**No full text is currently available online for this item,**" try the following steps:

First: Click "GO" next to "**Print Journal Collection**" to see if we have the issue of the journal in the library. (Look for the "Library Has (Summary)" field in the record for the journal). If the article is available in our print collection, you can come to Galvin Library, find the journal (shelved alphabetically) and read or copy the article.

Second: If Galvin Library does not have access to the document through another database or in our print holdings, use Interlibrary Loan to obtain the full text. Click “GO” next to “**Request document via MyILL**” to get the article sent to you from another library. You will need to log into your MyILL account to submit the request.
